



## **Common Assessment Framework**

**Early Intervention & Prevention** is a way of bringing agencies together to work more closely. It supports the early identification of children and young people with additional needs at a point where intervention can make a difference.

**If you work with children and young people on a basis where you can identify early unmet needs you need to attend; this applies to those working with adults who are also parents.** This includes staff in schools such as head teacher in the primary sector, SENCO, pastoral or behaviour specialists, designated teacher, or as the school decides. School nurses and health visitors, Community midwives, Children's centre staff, EWOs, YOS, Connexions, Youth workers, Educational psychologists, GPs, Police, substance misuse workers, therapists, nursery nurses, voluntary sector, housing support staff, and district council staff if their work involves contact with children and families.
