

Team around the Provider (TAP)

This is one of the possible outcomes from an Early Intervention and Prevention panel when the decision is not to convene a Team around the Child (TAC)

This concept is currently in development and will be part of the coordinators' role. Its development will be part of the permanent arrangements made for the Local Delivery Framework.

It can take the form of advice, to schools, over pupils of concern or to other agencies with children/families where guidance over the approach could be helpful. Support strategies may be offered where an issue will affect a number of children or young people and the CAF completer needs help on how to provide extra from within their own service.

TAP provides support for issues that are post CAF but do not reach the thresholds for social care. Support might be needed for multi-agency approaches that have been set up independent of the Local Delivery Framework. It is important that existing processes are accommodated but that there is no duplication.
