Children and Young People's Trust Vision Statement

"In Buckinghamshire we want all our children and young people to have the best start in life and to be able to lead safe, healthy and fulfilling lives, and to be able to make a positive contribution to their communities and to society. Our aim is to ensure access to a range of universal services as well as developing more targeted services to meet their specialist needs."

Aim of Group:

To ensure that progress, recommendations and actions in relation to the Programme are provided to the Board in a timely manner. The members of the group each have responsibility for driving forward implementation of the Local Delivery Framework across the county and partner agencies and more specifically within their own services to ensure a collaborative approach to the agenda linking in with all partners. Also, to consider and develop the models of governance and management for the individual LDAs.

Age group covered: 0-19 years (up to 25 years in the cases of young people leaving care and those with special needs). eCAF only covers children and young people up to their nineteenth birthday, however, partners still have a responsibility for children and young people post 19 and co-ordination of support is still necessary where needs are identified.

Groups affected: children and young people (0 to 19 years (up to 25 years in some circumstances), parents, carers and professionals.

Objectives of Group

- To lead on the progress of the Local Delivery Programme and coordinate the actions and targets agreed by the Local Delivery Programme Board.
- To support the Board by providing reports on the Action Plan (targets, milestones, risk assessments, issues logs etc.)
- To develop and maintain a communications plan to ensure that all partners are involved in the progress of the agenda and to cascade and communicate key messages to staff
- To champion change and lead on implementation in relevant service area
