

Work Experience, 2008.

A Young Person's Guide to the Children and Young People's Trust Leaflet.

On the 2nd June 2008, two young people from The Buckingham School joined the Partnership Delivery Team, Children and Young People's Services, for two weeks work experience.

Their project whilst with the team was to create a leaflet to explain the Children and Young People's Trust to young people in Buckinghamshire.

The young people created the leaflet by meeting and interviewing a selection of members from the Children and Young People's Trust Board. They then used their responses to produce the leaflet and contributed to the design of the leaflet itself.

During the initial designs of the leaflets we advised the young people involved that they needed to be aware of accessibility issues, and that they should try and use contrasting colours and bold text at all times. During the formal design process, we were in contact with Bucks Association for the Blind, ensuring that our designs were accessible for the visually impaired.

The leaflet was presented to the Trust Board on the 24th September by the two young people involved and was very well received.

The leaflet is used to promote the Children and Young People's Trust to young people across Buckinghamshire.
